Director of Projects and Infrastructure Development

The Director will play a critical leadership role in shaping the University's capital development program during a period of significant expansion.

Position Overview

Reporting to the Vice President for University Administration and serving as a member of the Executive Leadership and Management Board, the Director will provide strategic and operational leadership for planning, design, construction, commissioning, and closeout of major capital projects.

The portfolio includes campus utilities, civil infrastructure, water and sanitation systems, energy systems, security systems, and major building projects across current and future campuses.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead large-scale capital projects from concept through completion
- Manage scope, schedule, and budget for complex infrastructure programs
- Oversee contractor and consultant selection and negotiations
- Ensure regulatory compliance, quality control, and safety oversight
- Provide risk assessment and strategic reporting to executive leadership
- Supervise infrastructure personnel and manage project management systems
- Support sustainability initiatives and long-term campus infrastructure planning
- Coordinate with legal, procurement, and regulatory authorities

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Architecture, Engineering, Construction Management, or related field
- Minimum ten (5) years of leadership experience managing infrastructure and construction projects
 - Experience managing projects exceeding K25 million or capital programs exceeding K100 million
 - Demonstrated expertise in mechanical, electrical, civil, and utility systems
 - Strong experience in budget control, contractor negotiations, and project delivery
 - Proven leadership and supervisory experience
 - Excellent communication and stakeholder management skills

Preferred

- Experience in higher education or institutional environments
- Experience with sustainability initiatives and utility infrastructure
- Experience working with public agencies and regulatory bodies
